MINUTES OF THE 54th UTTIPEC GOVERNING BODY MEETING, HELD ON 22.6.2017 at 03.00 P.M. UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR OF DELHI.

The 54th Governing Body meeting of the UTTIPEC was held on 22.06.2017 at 3.00 P.M. at Raj Niwas under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble L.G. of Delhi. The detailed agenda items for discussion containing brief background and proposal of each project recommended by Working Groups and the Minutes of 53rd Governing Body meeting held on 23.11.2016 were circulated to members in advance. The list of members and participants, who attended this meeting is enclosed (Annexure 'X').

Member Secretary/UTTIPEC, DDA welcomed Hon'ble L.G., Chairman, UTTIPEC, Vice Chairman, DDA and other members to the 54th Governing Body meeting of UTTIPEC.

1. The Minutes of the 53rd Governing Body meeting circulated on 02.12.2016 were confirmed as no comments /observations were received from members.

2. Presentation of Projects-

(a) Integrated Transit Corridor development and street Network/Connectivity Plan for the corridor/influence zone along with detailed design of all intersections and mid sections based on traffic and feasibility studies for the corridor/network (Pragati Maidan)

Observations of the Governing Body:

Special Commissioner of Police (Traffic) explained about the security aspects within the proposed redevelopment scheme. PWD, GNCTD conveyed during the meeting that security concerns had been discussed with the securities agencies regarding the proposed tunnel below Pragati Maidan area and same have already been addressed in the proposal.

Decision of the Governing Body:

Based on the above observations, the proposal was approved with the rider that traffic projections should be very carefully reviewed especially the peak density of traffic.

- (b) Construction of half underpass on Outer Ring Road between Gopalpur Red light-Jagatpur Bridge - (PWD, GNCTD).

Organisation: PWD, GNCTD.

Observations of the Governing Body:

It was observed that the pedestrians may cross the Outer Ring road at grade. To discourage this jaywalking and to encourage the use of proposed pedestrian underpass it was suggested to install high railing on the central verge.

Decision of the Governing Body:

Based on the above observations, the proposal was approved.

- (c) Integrated Transit Corridor Development and Street Network / Connectivity Plan for Najafgarh area (Short term proposal) (PWD, GNCTD).

The proposal was approved.

- (d) Integrated Transit Corridor Development and Street Network /Connectivity Plan. (SH- Old Yamuna Bridge to Delhi- UP border (Apsara Border) and flyover at Shastri Park Junction and Seelampur Junction on G.T. Road.

Organisation: PWD, GNCTD.

Observations of the Governing Body

The proposal includes a Multilevel Parking at Gandhi Nagar. Governing Body agreed with the proposed parking facility, with the condition that PWD, GNCTD to explore alternate options to avoid concrete structure as construction of concrete Multilevel Parking will take longer time and difficult to dismantle in case of failure to serve the purpose or underutilized. PWD agreed for construction of multilevel parking using steel structure.

Traffic engineering solutions to be introduced.

Decision of the Governing Body

In view of the above observations, the proposal was approved by the Governing Body.

(e) Extension of existing Ashram flyover upto DND / Ring Road.

(f) Modified proposal for construction of Back to Back 'U'-turn on Road No-13-A, G.D. Marg, Sarita Vihar, New Delhi.

Decision of the Governing Body:

The proposal was approved.

(g) Feasibility of 3rd and 4th connectivity of Redevelopment of East Kidwai Nagar towards Barapullah Phase-II.

Observations of the Governing Body:

PWD, GNCTD and Delhi Traffic Police were of the opinion that the proposed at-grade signalized pedestrian crossing at the bottom of the ramp of the proposed Barapullah flyover will defeat the objective of signal free vehicular movement and will also compromise with the pedestrian safety. Accordingly, Governing Body disagreed with the proposed at-grade signalized pedestrian crossing and approved the proposed pedestrian subway for crossing Aurobindo Marg

Decision of the Governing Body:

Based on the above observations, the proposal of proposed pedestrian subway for crossing Aurobindo Marg with proper integration was approved.

The proposal was approved.

- (b) **Integrated Transit Corridor Development and Street Network / Connectivity Plan for the influence zone of the corridor of Pusta Road from Shastri Park intersection to Sabhapur Border via Khajuri Khas Chowk (Length approx. 7 Km)**

Organisation: **PWD, GNCTD.**

Presented by: **Chief Project Manager, F-2, PWD, GNCTD**

Observations of the Governing Body:

Governing body observed that 60m. Right of Way (ROW) of Marginal Bund road to be demarcated and if vacant stretch is available along the corridor within the ROW, the same may be developed as green. PWD, GNCTD in consultation with Landscape Department, DDA and other stakeholders to work out the proposal.

Decision of the Governing Body:

Based on the above observations, Governing Body directed PWD to review the proposal of widening of Marginal Bund Road. However, the proposal of vehicular underpass at Khajuri Khas intersection was approved.

Action: PWD GNCTD

Governing Body issued the following advisory:

- (i) Status of the proposal which are approved in the Governing Body meeting are to be presented in the next Governing Body by the road owning / implementing agencies.

Action: Road Owning Agencies

- (ii) All the proposal to be justified with the peak and projected traffic data. The same are to be presented in the Governing Body meetings.

Action: Road Owning Agencies




- (iii) Secretary, Delhi Urban Arts Commission (DUAC) to be invited in the Governing Body meetings.
