MINUTES OF THE 10th UTTIPEC MEETING, HELD ON 9.1.2009 AT 11.00 A.M., UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE HON'BLE LT. GOVERNOR OF DELHI.

- 1 A meeting of the UTTIPEC was held on 9.1.2009 at 11.00 A.M. at Vikas Minar, under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi. The detailed agenda points for discussion for UTTIPEC meeting was circulated during the meeting. List of members and participants who attended the meeting is placed as Annexure 'A'.
- V.C.,DDA, welcomed the Hon'ble L.G., Delhi & conveyed "New Year Greetings". A.C.(Plg.)III, DDA welcomed the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, VC, DDA, Chairman-NDMC and other members for the 10th meeting of UTTIPEC. Being the first meeting of UTTIPEC for this year, New Year Greetings were conveyed to all the members on behalf of core team of UTTIPEC, DDA. L.G./Chairman, UTTIPEC reciprocated New Year Greetings to all present & wished for a continued, cohesive & committed action by all the members in serving the mobility needs of Delhi residents, as per UTTIPEC charter.
- 3. Draft Minutes of the UTTIPEC meeting held on 12.12.08 issued vide No.F.1(2)08/UTTIPEC/9th/D-20 dt:7.1.2009. were circulated during the meeting. Since there were no observations, the same were confirmed.
- 4. Brief review of actions arising out of UTTIPEC meeting held on 12.12.08.
 - a) Status of actions arising out of UTTIPEC meeting of 21.11.08
 Status of actions was informed as stated in the detailed agenda points 2
 (a) –(i) to (v) circulated during the meeting.
 - L.G. desired that all the agencies must make special efforts for timely follow up action with a feedback report to UTTIPEC Secretariat. The Advisor (Special Projects) to L.G. was requested to monitor the timely compliance of ATR.

(Action: All concerned)

b) Status of actions arising out of UTTIPEC meeting of 12.12.08.

i) M.D., DIMTS informed that as per terms of reference the RITES study is likely to be completed by March 2009. Hence, the integrated multi-modal draft transportation plan by DIMTS would be submitted after March 2009. L.G. desired that interactive efforts of all UTTIPEC members/experts may however continue with emphasis on improved public transport system in Delhi.

(Action: DIMTS/all members)

ii) MD, DIMTS agreed to make available advanced traffic data (based on RITES study) on ring road/outer ring road & other 55 arterial roads to LTA Singapore, with a copy to UTTIPEC by 3rd week of Jan'2009

(Action:DIMTS)

iii) All the Road Owning Agencies specially MCD & PWD were requested to finalize design specifications for crash barrier/divider & central railing for selected roads for consideration of working group-II-B.

(Action: All Road Owning Agencies)

iv) It was presented during the meeting that UTTIPEC Directory as updated up to 31.12.08 is already uploaded on DDA -UTTIPEC website, with the names of concerned officers. L.G. appreciated the efforts & desired that a hard copy of the UTTIPEC Directory (nicely printed) be also made available to all the members. With a view to expedite ATR on public suggestions forwarded by AAUI/UTTIPEC, L.G. requested Sh.Bhaskar Mitra, Advisor (Special Projects) to take a follow up meeting with the concerned road owning agencies

(Action: UTTIPEC/All road owning agencies)

- v) Jt.Commr.Traffic informed that repeated drives to streamline parking
- vi) problems in Lajpat Nagar, as well as at Ashirwad chowk (Dwarka) were undertaken by traffic police. However, the sub-group report indicating specific 'short term & long term parking solutions' for these areas, as per the decisions of 9th UTTIPEC meeting would be submitted shortly.

(Action:Jt.Commr.Traffic)

vi) Eng.-in-Chief MCD presented the follow up actions on rectification of deficiencies pointed out by the 'quality audit report' on MCD Wazirpur road by DCE. It was informed that expression of interest(EOI) is also being issued by MCD, to ensure improved quality & specifications in future road construction works. L.G. appreciated the positive actions taken by MCD in this regard.

(Action:Eng-in-Chief,MCD)

vii) President AAUI submitted a "Status report on existing subways & foot over bridges" ,compiled by AAUI, New Delhi.

The report highlights the lack of upkeep & maintenance of these facilities by the concerned civic authorities. L.G. acknowledge the efforts of AAUI & constituted a small group under Jt.Commr.(Police) with representatives from concerned civic agency, UTTIPEC and representative of AAUI to undertake inspections & improvement works in the interest of road users. The outcome of the sub group be monitored by Working Group –V.

(Action:Jt.Commr.Traffic/ Working Group V.)

5. Brief report of working group meetings

Brief report of working group meeting of I-A, II-B, IV & V (as contained in detailed agenda note circulated) was presented during the meeting by the respective chairman. The power point presentation on road markings prepared by working group-III, was deferred for presentation for the next meeting.

(Action:Jt.Commr.Traffic)

6. Presentation of projects recommended by Working Group II-B for consideration of UTTIPEC.

a) Conceptual transport plan for games venue site at Talkatora Stadium was approved, along with observations of the working group. Sh.Narayanaswami, Advisor, Common Wealth Games presented 4 alternative routes based on different considerations. However, the alternative recommended by traffic police was found to be most appropriate & approved. The need to have 'contingency plan' as well as "traffic diversion plan" for all the games venue routes was emphasized during the meeting. Jt.Commr.Police informed that traffic police has already finalised these plans. L.G. desired that these be discussed with Spl.Advisor, Common Wealth Games, GNCTD.

(Action: All concerned agencies/ Jt.Commr.Police)

b) Review of progress of 49 road improvement proposals earlier approved by UTTIPEC:

Eng.-in-Chief, MCD & PWD presented the status of ATR for 11 & 25 roads, respectively. L.G. acknowledged the efforts. It was emphasized to further expedite the improvement actions and the revised status be presented in the next UTTIPEC Meeting. The road owning agencies were requested to provide a brief one page write-up on each of the improvement actions carried out by them along with photographs of 'before' & 'after' (the improvement works) to UTTIPEC. On receipt of the ATR it is to be uploaded on UTTIPEC website.

(Action: All road owning agencies/ UTTIPEC)

c) Other projects:

i)Eng.-in-Chief, MCD drew attention of L.G. about the corridor improvement proposal of Rani Jhansi Road which was earlier approved by the DDA Technical Committee. In view of existing religious structure affected by the alignment, the revision was necessitated. In view of importance of the project, the revised proposal was approved with codal processing formalities to be completed by the working group II-B.

(Action: Eng.-in-Chief, MCD/ Working Group II-B) ii) The Eng.-in-Chief, MCD presented the new technique of patch repair work/potholes on bitumen/asphalt roads. It was informed that a technical team from MCD has already been sent to Thailand to examine the possibility of importing the necessary technology & the hardware in this regard. It was also shared that the same technology have been successfully used in Kolkata. UTTIPEC acknowledged the efforts made by MCD & requested Eng.-in-Chief MCD to update UTTIPEC & other road owning agencies & share MCD's experiences in this regard.

(Action: Eng.-in-Chief,MCD)

7. Projects for information of Governing Body:

The status on traffic circulation & management plan around New Delhi Railway Station & on modified proposal of JB Tito Marg, was noted.

8. Briefing about other important meetings:.

The progress of meetings with SIEMENS(Germany) & LTA Singapore as stated in detailed agenda note under item No.6 (a) & (b), were presented during the meeting. Further actions taken in both the cases are to be placed in the next meeting of UTTIPEC.

9 Vision/Action Plan for modernization of transport system in Delhi:

After detailed deliberations on the subject, a sub-group under Pr.Secy-cum-Commissioner(Transport) GNCTD with members from Traffic Police, DMRC, Northern Railways, NHAI, DIMTS & UTTIPEC was constituted to prepare a 'base paper' for discussion during the next UTTIPEC meeting. It was also decided that in the meantime an interim reply be sent by UTTIPEC to MOUD, GOI with reference to their letter dated 18.12.08.

(Action: Pr.Secy.-cum-Commr. (Transport)GNCTD & UTTIPEC.

10. Delhi Urban Art Commission reference about UTTIPEC notification.

The DUAC letter dated 8.12.08 with observations as contained in agenda points was discussed. L.G., clarified that all the mandatory clearances including DUAC are required to be sought by the project executing agencies, as per procedure. With this clarification, DUAC may be requested to nominate their representative for working group II-A & II-B for their valued contribution. Suitable reply be sent to DUAC by the Member Secretary, UTTIPEC.

(Action: UTTIPEC/All road Owning Agencies)

11. Action taken note on references received from RajNiwas.

Following 6 references were deliberated:

- i. Cement concrete roads in Delhi
- ii. Regarding Whisper concrete

- iii. PWD adopts new road tech from 2010
- iv. Use of Carbon core material asphalt
- v. Removal of Central Verge on Nizamuddin bridge
- vi. Upgradation of roads around ISBT Anand Vihar, MPT/Railway Terminal Anand Vihar and Patparganj Industrial area.

E.M., DDA/Chairman working group II-B briefly presented the deliberations of working group meeting of 6.1.09 on above references. It was decided that concerned agencies may further process follow-up action. After review, the working group to come out with clear recommendations for consideration of the Governing Body of UTTIPEC.

12. Any other item with the permission of the chair.

During the deliberations on detailed agenda points, following specific decisions were taken:

i) In areas where parking problems are critical, nearest available vacant lands could be considered for 'temporary parking' in consultation with the land owning agencies, till these pockets are developed for specific assigned use.

(Action: Jt.Commr.Traffic)

ii) UTTIPEC must have all essential computer aided design equipments (A0 size coloured scanner, plotter, auto cad software, digital camera, digital projections system, adobe acrobat professional software etc.) by the next meeting. This is envisaged to equip UTTIPEC in providing constructive, creative, cost-effective value addition improvements in the transportation projects taken up by different agencies.

(Action: DDA)

iii) All the UTTIPEC member agencies were directed by the Chairman to ensure that soft copy of their presentation material is made available to UTTIPEC, at least 2 days in advance of the scheduled Governing Body Meeting.

(Action: All concerned)

- **13.** Next meeting of the UTTIPEC was fixed for Friday 6th Feb'2009 at 11.00 A.M. at Vikas Minar, DDA Office.
- **14.** The meeting ended with thanks to the chair.
